	Speech by Mr. Rosen	• <i>Atsumi, Sachiko, Yuko, Masako set the drums on stage & brings Montessori students on stage</i>
Kanade (12:10)	Intro/Slow Part	• Flute is in the back of 2nd row • Montessori is sitting
	Main Part	• Everyone, including Montessori plays
Hado	Megumi Solo	• During 16 x of "Don Don" 2nd row of Center Row moves up & Center Row becomes one line of 11 drums • Chieko & Hitomi brings Children during Megumi & Yuka solo
	Yuka Solo <i>STOP after "Dodo-nko" 8x</i>	• ALL Center Row joins "Dodo-nko" 8x w/ Yuka **After "Dodo-nko" x 8, EVERYONE STOPS playing
	Children Solo (Part 1) <i>STOP after "Dodo-nko" 8x</i>	*Starting from the Bell* • 1st part, Mika, JJ, Rio, Emiko, Serina • Other children waits for 2nd part **After "Dodo-nko" x 8, EVERYONE STOPS playing • <i>Mika & JJ switches Maya, Kyla</i> • <i>Sachiko takes Mika, JJ & Emiko off Stage L after 1st part</i>
	Children Solo (Part 2)	*Starting from the Bell* • Teen waits behind children

	Teen	• Hikari joins Teen Solo • Montessori Kindergarten prepares beside Stage L • Sachiko & Atsumi prepares 2 shimedaiko for Montessori solo (the ones JJ & Mika were using)
	Jason Solo <i>STOP after "Dodo-nko" 8x</i>	• After "Dodo-nko" x 8 STOP playing • Teen (for Katsugi) divides up into Stage R/L group • <i>Atsumi & Tomoko moves the drums in front of Center Row</i>
	Montessori Solo	• Entering from Stage L-> Exiting from Stage R • Sakura follows Montessori from Stage L->Stage R • S Team line up in order of Solo • <i>Sachiko & Atsumi put away shimedaiko to Stage R</i>
	Sakura Solo	• S-Team prepares and waits behind Sakura • Katsugi breaks down stands and prepares for solo
	S-Team Solo <i>Plays to the END</i>	
	Katsugi	• S-Team sit and wait at Center Row • <i>Katsugi splits & moves BACK of Center Row</i>
	Everyone	• <i>Shamisen players will leave to prepare for 1:05 performance</i> • <i>Maturiza members will take out the Center Row drums (Hikeki) & 3 Drums used in Shamisen</i>
